

PSSA Snowmobile & ATV Show

Rules & Regulations

1. Recreation Unlimited, all its agents and employees, will be considered show management and you will be required to follow all guidelines set forth by them.
2. Recreation Unlimited will make assignment of exhibit spaces guided by exhibitor's merchandise to maintain a proper distribution of services; Recreation Unlimited reserves the right to make changes to the floor plan and/or relocate an exhibitor.
3. Exhibitors will comply with all instructions dealing with setup, tear down, parking, and table/aisle spacing.
4. Exhibitors will not pack up or leave prior to the published close of the show. This includes bringing in cartons, boxes, racks or any other packing materials; dismantling displays; packing merchandise; etc.
5. There is no smoking in the building.
6. No goods will be permitted to be placed in the exhibit space prior to Recreation Unlimited's receipt of complete payment of booth space and appropriate extra services.
7. Recreation Unlimited reserves the right to decline or prohibit any product or prohibit any activity which, in its opinion, is not suitable for the PSSA Snowmobile & ATV Show.
8. Recreation Unlimited will not discriminate upon any dealer or patron due to race, sex, or religion.
9. Exhibitors must notify Recreation Unlimited of all products and services that they will sell at the show.
10. No exhibitor shall sublet or share the whole or any part of the allotted space or have representative's equipment or materials from businesses other than his own, as agreed to by contract with Recreation Unlimited.
11. Exhibitors must obtain a sales tax license for operation in Pennsylvania; exhibitor agrees that all sales made at the show will be duly reported in accordance to Pennsylvania state tax rules and regulations; exhibitors must issue receipts for each sale, paid stickers are highly recommended for merchandise.
12. Exhibitors are responsible for any loss or damage to their own merchandise; exhibitor shall not hold Recreation Unlimited responsible or liable for any loss or damage, theft or injury to any merchandise, employees, or guests of exhibitor.
13. Recreation Unlimited will not be responsible for acts of God, theft, fire, or loss of personal or salable properties.
14. The use of sound devices, video equipment, loud speakers, radio sets or any other loud sound reproduction equipment, shall be controlled so as not to disturb neighboring exhibitors or disrupt the integrity of The PSSA Snowmobile & ATV Show.
15. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up their booths and for breaking down all cardboard boxes.
16. Exhibitors, and their employees, must wear "exhibitor buttons" during the show, and when entering the building so as to identify them as separate from customers; exhibitor buttons will be provided by Recreation Unlimited upon check-in and will require a one dollar (\$1) refundable deposit per button.

All show rules will be strictly enforced. Not following any one of the above regulations will result in forfeiting your security deposit.
